

MDRC General Information on Joining the Club or Continuing Your Membership

NEW/PROSPECTIVE MEMBER:

As a prospective new member, you need to read the Membership Information posted and complete the Application Form and Background Check Waiver Form. When returning the completed Application form and the Background Check Waiver be sure to include the \$40.00 fee for the background check, **do not send cash**. Some states charge more to complete the background check, if so, the Secretary will contact you of the additional fee.

Once the background check is returned clearing you of any reason not permitting you from possessing a firearm you will be contacted by the Secretary giving you the date of the mandatory meeting with the range Directors and requesting you to electronically send a photo (portrait) for your I.D. Card.

At the scheduled meeting you will be asked to tell us a little about yourself, your interest in the shooting sports, how you learned of the range and what you type of shooting you are most interested in.

The club range rules are posted and you may read them at your convenience. They will be covered again during this meeting. You will then be taken around the range, showing the various shooting areas, what is permitted and not permitted in each of them. Feel free to ask any questions you may have.

You will be asked to pay a \$100.00 dollar initiation fee and the \$120.00 Annual Membership Fee. Total is \$220.00.

You will be issued one RFID card giving you access to the gate, bench house and restroom. This card is only to be used by you. You will be charged a \$25.00 fee in you lose the card. If you have sent a photo the membership will also be given to you, if not your photo will be taken and the membership card mailed to you.

CURRENT MEMBER RENEWAL

The membership fee is still \$120.00. Continued membership in the NRA is required. The Work Waiver fee will remain at \$100.00 this coming year (2023) but will increase to \$200.00 for the 2024 year. As in the past you can meet the work requirement in many different ways; scheduled work days, special projects, mowing, trimming, help with setup and teardown of matches. Also, we are aware of health issues that may limit your ability to meet these tasks. Contact us and we will find a way to help you meet the waiver.
