Importance of keeping the club advised of a change of your email address or PSN. The email is how we will contact you concerning details of importance. This past year we have had several instances where the member's email address has changed. Some places allow you to keep your email address when you leave, but you may no longer regularly check it. Same goes for your phone number. Most people keep their number when they change service providers, but not all.

Speaking of Range Work Days, they are all on the last Saturday of each month, April through October. Some have stated they cannot make the weekend dates. There is always trimming or trash clean-up needing to be done along the roadway coming into the range. Policing brass in the Action Bays is always needed. Contact me about using this for work time. Down range trimming is limited to the time when we are mowing downrange. From time-to-time other projects that can be handled without shutting the range down. One of our work details will involve removing the larger rocks from the face of the Small-Bore Metallic berms and moving dirt into Action Bay berms where they are becoming eroded (shot out). We will not pile this job on one person, but a crew of multiple workers.

We are also starting construction of a Club House rather than continuing to use the Clubroom in the old building. It will be built above the Rest Room. We have needed a modern facility for many years for classes and meetings. We are developing plans for its use. Suggestions accepted.

Still waiting on the range alarm system. That work is dependent on a contractor. He has been busy
and will hopefully get to it soon. We discussed setting up a temporary alarm system, but turned the
idea down. For safety, members using the ends of the range need to be notified whenever someone is
going down range. Especially to the 200-yard line.
